Winter Safety Tip #2 PREVENT POISONING

Protect your baby against these potential toxins, often found in homes this season.

- Mistletoe, holly berries, Jerusalem cherry, wild arum, yew, and amaryllis
- Alcoholic drinks (such as eggnog, punch, or glögg) and cigarette or cigar butts
- Artificial-snow spray
- Fire salts
- Prescription medicines from visiting relatives

Cozy fireplaces and decorative candles can quickly turn dangerous. Here's how to avoid the risks.

- Don't leave your child alone with lit candles.
- Don't put wrapping paper in the fireplace—it may contain materials that are toxic if burned.
- Don't dispose of wreaths and evergreens in the fireplace—they're likely to cause a flash fire and smoke up a room. □
